Arrival and Dismissal in K Parking Lot: Thank you to the Rosedell Dad's Club for helping with arrival drop off in the K Parking lot. We appreciate your understanding of a few changes to help the process go smoothly:

When arriving and dropping off children in the morning, drive to the outer lane of cones to pull up to the curb to drop students off or pick up.

When driving through the lot, with no children to pick up or drop off, drive to the inner cones as a throughway.

On Wednesdays, and any day the entire school is dismissed at the same time, please park your car and walk to pick up your children.

Please do not park in the shopping center parking lot and walk to pick up your children. The shopping center has called Rosedell to complain of parents who are doing this-taking up parking places for their paying customers.
