Transitional Kindergarten & Kindergarten Round Up: Transitional Kindergarten (TK) and Kindergarten Round Up week is February 23rd – February 27th. You may pick up TK and K enrollment packets the week of February 16th. Registration will start on Monday, February 23rd at 8:30am in the MPR. Here are the requirements:

- Age Requirements: Kindergarten entry – children that turn 5 by September 1st. Transitional Kindergarten – children that turn 5 between September 2nd and December 2nd.
- Original birth certificate provided by the County Registrar/County Recorder or passport
- Verification of immunizations
- Dental screening – forms will be available at time of registration
- Proof of residency – two original items are required to complete registration – utility bills, contracts, statement or payment receipts with address (No cell phone bills), lease/escrow/rental papers, property tax payment receipts, pay stub, voter registration

Rosedell Child Development Program Before and After School Care and Preschool:

Priority Registration School-Age Program (Before and After School): The Child Development Programs (CDP) priority registration for the 2015-2016 School-Age Program is scheduled to begin February 9th. If you are currently enrolled in the School-Age Program and have a zero balance on your account, your Site Supervisor will be emailing you an online registration link for the 2015-2016 school year. In order to guarantee your continued enrollment, registration must be completed by Friday, February 20th.

Kindergarten School-Age Program Registration: The Child Development Programs Incoming TK/Kindergarten School-Age Program registration will be held as a lottery. Please see the Child Development Program Site Supervisor during the week of February 23rd – 27th, 2015 to complete the *TK/Kindergarten Interest Form*. The lottery will be held on Tuesday, March 3rd. All families will be contacted to notify them if their child was selected for the program or if their child has been placed on a wait list. Families placed on the wait list will be based on the number drawn in the lottery. If you have any questions, please contact the Child Development Program Site Supervisor, Heather Gonzales at 661-294-5336.

Preschool Registration: Rosedell Preschool offers a multi-day option. Priority will be given to families with a child who will be four years old on or before September 1st, of the current school year, who live within Rosedell boundaries and who desire the 5-day preschool program. A 3-day (Monday/Wednesday/Friday) and a 2-day (Tuesday/Thursday) program are also an option based on space availability. In addition, if space permits, children who reach three years of age by September 1st of the current school year, may also be enrolled in the 2-day, 3-day, or 5-day option. The program operates daily from 8:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Please see the Child Development Program Site Supervisor during the week of February 23rd – February 27th to complete a *Preschool Interest Form*. The lottery will be held on Wednesday, March 4th. All families will be contacted to notify them if their child was selected for the program or if their child has been placed on a wait list. Families placed on the wait list will be based on the number drawn in the lottery. If space permits at other preschool sites, parents will be referred to sites where there is availability. Emblem Full-Day Preschool: The Child Development Programs are offering a year-round, full-day and multi-day (2, 3, or 5 day), preschool program (6:30 am – 6:00 pm) within the SUSD boundaries. Children who are three or four on or before September 1st of the current school year, and reside within SUSD boundaries are eligible. Children residing outside of SUSD boundaries will be eligible to enroll, space permitting.

State Preschool: A half-day state preschool program is available to income eligible children who will be four on or before September 1st of the current school year. This program is available within the Saugus Union School District at both Cedar creek and Rio Vista Child Development Programs. If space permits, children who are three on or before September 1st of the current school year will be enrolled.
