**Daylight Saving Time Begins on March 8 – Set Your Clocks One Hour Ahead:** In addition to changing out the batteries in smoke/carbon monoxide alarms, dedicate some time to evaluate emergency supplies for alternate sources of light during a power outage. Some recommended sources of light include: flashlight lights, LED candles, light sticks, solar powered lights, solar powered generators, and gasoline/propane/diesel generators. *Don't be left in the dark!*

Outage checklist:

- Have a battery-operated radio to access news updates
- Keep a portable charger for smart phone/laptops/tablets
- Fresh batteries for all necessary equipment
- Store non-perishable food that does not require cooking
- Have a manual can opener
- Install surge protectors to help safeguard valuable electronic equipment such as computers, home entertainment systems, and kitchen appliances
- Learn how to manually open an automatic garage door or gate, without power
- Place flashlights in handy locations - near telephones
- Back up important files on your computer
- Know where your utilities are located and how to turn them off
- Keep vehicles with a half a tank of fuel (gas pumps not operable during a power outage)
- Have extra cash on hand (ATMS not operable during a power outage)
