Allergies: Some of our students have severe food allergies to peanuts and shellfish. Strict avoidance is the only way to prevent an allergic reaction. A reaction can be triggered by contact or eating peanuts. Because a reaction can be fatal and happen within minutes, we are asking for your help in reducing the chance of an allergic reaction. Listed below are some guidelines to help all of us ensure that we are doing everything we can to keep all students safe and healthy.

Please remind your child not to share food at school and to follow the school procedures for clean up before and after eating. If at all possible, please select alternatives to peanut butter and peanut items. If your child will only eat peanut butter sandwiches, we ask that you please use plastic wrap or bags.

We have taken precautions at school to also ensure the safety of our students with allergies. I appreciate your assistance and understanding. Should you have any questions, please feel free to call the office.
