Parents and families are essential partners in promoting good attendance because they have the bottom line responsibility for making sure their children get to school every day.

Safety Notice: For the safety of all our Rosedell children, we ask that you use extreme caution and follow all traffic laws when driving to and from the school. Please do not block the cross walks. **Make sure your children use the cross walks.** Cell phones should never be used while driving. The safety and well-being of each of our precious children is our top priority. Please remind your children that if they are walking home, they need to go straight home and not linger around after school. Our crossing guards are on duty after school to assist students crossing the street until 3:20pm. This allows enough time for all students to have crossed our nearby busy intersections.

Birthday Celebrations: Our District's Wellness Policy focuses on health and nutrition education. If you would like to have your child celebrate their birthday with their class, please send in a new book for the teacher to read to the class. After the book is shared with your child's class, it will be donated to their class or school library.

Please do not send drinks, cupcakes, edible treats, balloons or flowers to school. Also, please remember that teachers and staff cannot distribute class address lists or hand out invitations for birthday parties.

Tips From The School Health Office: Sometimes it can be difficult for a parent to decide whether to send children to school when they wake up with early symptoms of an illness or complaints that they do not feel well. In general, during cold and flu season, unless your child is significantly ill, the best place for them is in school. Please remind and show your children to discard used tissues promptly, not to share personal items, to cover their mouths when they cough or sneeze, to keep their hands away from their face, and to wash hands thoroughly and often with soap and warm water. Suggest that they silently sing the Happy Birthday song twice while washing their hands.

However, there are some situations in which it is best to plan on keeping your child home for a day to rest or to arrange for an appointment with your health care provider. The following are a few such situations that warrant watching and possibly conferring with your health care provider:

- Persistent fever greater than 100.4 orally, including a fever that requires control with medication.
- Sore throat that is severe, accompanied by fever and/or feeling ill, that persists longer than 48 hours.
- Red, runny eyes that distract the child from learning.
- Severe ear pain or drainage from the ear.
- Severe headache, especially if accompanied by fever.

Remember, whenever you keep your child home from school, please call the office in advance of the start of the school day and leave a detailed message indicating the reason for the absence.

Kindergarten & Transitional Kindergarten Round Up Week February 26, 2018 - March 2, 2018

New families to SUSD will have the opportunity beginning February 23 to use the Online Registration Tool in Infinite Campus to register Kindergarten/TK students for the 2018-2019 school year. If you have students currently enrolled in SUSD, please use the Parent Portal to register your incoming Kindergarten/TK student.

Use the Registration Link below or visit your zoned school to use a Kiosk. Upon completing the online application, **please retain your application confirmation number for future use, as well as a printed copy of your student's application.** You will need to bring the printed application as well as proof (original documents) of the items listed below to your zoned school during the week of Kindergarten Round Up to complete the enrollment process.

Age Requirements:

Kindergarten Entry- Children that turn 5 on or before September 1.
Transitional Kindergarten "TK"- Children that turn 5 between September 2 and December 2.

The following Birth Certificate and Health information is required to complete registration:

- Original birth certificate provided by the County Registrar/County Recorder or passport
- Verification of immunization against:
 - o diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis (DTP)
 - o polio (OPV or IPV)
 - o measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR)
 - o hepatitis B
 - o varicella (chickenpox)

Please Note: Dental Screening forms will be available at time of registration. Completed forms are due to the school office by the beginning of May.

Proof of Residency- two original items are required to complete registration. Refer to list below for acceptable documents to use for proof of residency:

- Utility bills, contracts, statement or payment receipts w/address (cell phone bills not accepted)
- Lease/Escrow/Rental papers w/address
- Property Tax payment receipts
- Pay stub
- Voter registration
- Correspondence from a government agency

ALL STUDENTS MUST BE IMMUNIZED TO ATTEND SCHOOL. CALIFORNIA LAW PROHIBITS STUDENTS' ATTENDING SCHOOL WITHOUT COMPLETE IMMUNIZATION RECORDS. IF NECESSARY, MEDICAL EXEMPTIONS MUST BE ON FILE IN THE SCHOOL OFFICE.
