School Safety Message from the Principal: We hope you all received the important message “Safety and Security in the Saugus Union School District” that was sent out by our Superintendent, Dr. Lucid, last week. This message was emailed out to all our Saugus parents through Constant Contact. If you did not receive it, please let our front office know and we will be happy to provide you with a hard copy. This message included important information updating our Saugus families in regards to safety and security at all our school sites across the District. In our efforts to increase school security, the District continues to implement changes to ensure all our students are safe at school. Much of these increased security measures have been made possible due to funding from Measure EE.

At Rosedell, school safety is our top priority. Last week there were two separate incidents that occurred causing deep concern amongst our Rosedell families regarding the safety of our Rosedell students. Although letters were sent out to each of the grade levels involved, I feel it is important to address any safety concerns you may have at this time. Each of the two incidents that occurred last week involved a student writing a threatening message directed at one or more of our other students. One was sent out while playing a video game and the other was a written on a piece of paper. Both of these incidents were taken very serious and investigated thoroughly. We worked closely with law enforcement and our District Administrators to ensure all necessary precautions and appropriate measures were taken. After a full investigation, these threats were deemed unfounded and at no time were any of our students in any danger. We understand how upsetting and frightening these incidents may have been to some of our students. Please continue to let me know of any safety concerns you may have. We appreciate your help and support in ensuring the safety and well-being of all our Rosedell children.
