**Character Counts:** For the months of October/November, Rosedell will focus on the Character Counts Pillar of **Citizenship**. Citizenship is respecting authority and the law. Citizenship is doing your share as a good neighbor and citizen. Students demonstrating excellent citizenship follow the rules, respect the principles of democracy, and help to make things better. Please continue to reinforce the importance of being a good citizen.

**Flu Vaccine:** LA County Public Health is recommending Flu shots for those 6 months of age and older. Those most at risk are between 2-5 years old and pregnant women. The flu shot is considered the first line immunization; nasal spray flu vaccine is not recommend but is used for children who won't take shots. Children who have never had the flu shot before need two flu shots 4 weeks apart. The flu vaccine and TDAP are recommended for all women in their 3<sup>rd</sup> trimester of pregnancy.
